## ABOUT THE CONFERENCE:

Postmodernism has dominated the cultural sphere since the 1960s, and it has become an embedded umbrella term that pervades the theoretical framework of contemporary critical analysis. Alan Kirby in an influential essay, 'Death of Postmodernism and Beyond' (2006) has proclaimed the shift from postmodernism to 'Digimodernism', commensurate with the digital revolution that characterises 21st century life and culture. The critical theories [viz. post-postmodernism (Turner), meta-modernism (Vermeulen and van den Akker), trans-postmodernism (Epstein)] that have proliferated in the last two decades, to characterize an era in the 'aftermath' of postmodernism; categorically or tangentially (albeit, ironically!), fall under the rubric of the postmodern. Even the critics who ostensibly distance themselves from the tenets of postmodernism, take it as a point of departure. The gargantuan shadow of postmodernism undeniably encroaches upon all forms of cultural phenomena still. It is therefore, imperative to interrogate the predominance as well as the waning effects and traces of the seemingly ubiquitous interpretive lens of postmodernism. Is cultural criticism still entangled in the deeply rooted matrix of postmodern critical methodology? How has the locus of identity metamorphosed in tandem with the sociocultural transformations? This international conference would attempt to deliberate the (dis)/continuities of the postmodern turn to determine the locus of contemporary cultural mores vis-à-vis the theoretical modes of criticism. We are thus encouraging you to 'unravel' (in the true sense of the term) the behemoth of postmodernism, so as to (or not to!) reach towards a critical consensus.
